Dear Sir,

On behalf of the President of India, sealed tenders are invited from competent and well experienced contractors for the following work on works contract basis.

- 1) Name of Work** : **Collection, treatment and safe disposal of FRP waste from NFC**
- 2) Scope** : As per Annexure-I
- 3) Duration of Contract** : **6 months** from the date of commencement of work.
- 4) Estimated Cost** : **Rs 48,94,500/-** (Rupees Forty Lakhs only)
- 5) Earnest Money Deposit** : **Rs 97,890/-** (Rupees Eighty Thousand only)
(2% of estimated cost)

EMD in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt / Crossed Demand Draft drawn in favour of "Pay and Accounts Officer, NFC" payable at Hyderabad shall be submitted. Offers without EMD will be summarily rejected. Name & A/C No. of the contractor may be written at the backside of the DD submitted towards EMD and the DD to be submitted shall be drawn after the date of release of NIT to ensure that it is valid for the entire offer period.

- 6) Issue of tender document** : From 17.12.2018 to 31.12.2018
- 7) Last date for submission of tender** : **08.01.2019** up to 1400 hours.
- 8) Date of opening the sealed tenders** : 08.01.2019 at 1430 hours.
- 9) Cost of tender document** : Rs 500/- (Demand draft or banker's cheque payable at Hyderabad drawn in favour of "Pay and Accounts Officer, NFC")

Quotations are to be submitted strictly in the format enclosed. Tender and EMD shall be placed in two separate envelopes clearly indicating tender No. and each marked as TENDER & EMD respectively. Both the envelopes shall be submitted together in another sealed envelope superscribing Tender No. & description of work along with due date and time of submission on the outer cover.

Your offers shall be dropped in tender box kept for the purpose at North Gate, Nuclear Fuel Complex, ECIL Post, Hyderabad – 500062, on or before 08.01.2019 up to 1400 hours.

Tenders will be opened at Works Section, IIIrd floor, Aadhar Building, NFC. Late / delayed & tenders not accompanied by EMD shall not be considered.

I. Eligibility Criteria: Only the contractors with the following clearance certificates / licenses will be considered :

- a) State Pollution Control Board's Clearance: Consent order For Operation (CFO) issued by State Pollution Control Board.
- b) State Industrial License Registrars certificate to operate the Industry

II. General Conditions:

1. The contractor shall maintain Hazardous Waste Manifest system for collection of material.
2. The contractor will be completely responsible for the job. The contractor shall deploy sufficient workmen for the completion of the job.
3. No child labour should be engaged.
4. Contract labours for material movement within NFC premises are to be engaged in General Shift only.
5. The workers engaged by the contractor should wear uniform which is distinct from NFC uniform. Safety shoes and other PPEs as required for the job are to be provided by the contractor for all the workers engaged by him and ensure its usage. The contractor has to ensure safe working practices and follow all safety rules and regulations stipulated by SED, NFC from time to time.
6. The Contractor must follow all Labour Laws such as Contractor (Regulation & Abolition Act), Payment of Wages Act, EPF & MP Act, ESI Act, Payment of Bonus Act, Employees Compensation Act etc. NFC reserves right to ask Contractor to furnish proofs /documentary evidence for following the above laws. Clarifications on statutory provisions if any, may be sought from Welfare Officer, NFC, Hyderabad on 040-27183059 or wo@nfc.gov.in on any working day during office hours.
7. Wages are to be paid as per Minimum Wages Act, notified by RLC (C) / State Government of Telangana, whichever is higher from time to time.
8. The contractor shall produce necessary police verification certificates from the local police station for the manpower being engaged for the purpose.
9. The contractors shall submit filled in Annexure II in the absence of which their offer shall be deemed invalid.
10. Contractor will be given advance intimation regarding the waste to be collected. Contractor will make the necessary arrangements accordingly.
11. Contractors shall provide the details for the arrangement of collection using own manpower and transport, e.g. whether the waste will be collected in a truck or by any other vehicle. The contractor shall also give brief description of the process and the safe disposal methods that will be adopted for each type of waste from NFC.
12. Loading of FRP waste in the vehicle shall be in NFC's scope.
13. For permitting vehicles inside NFC, the vehicle documents must be proper and valid. Driver & Helpers deputed for collection of material should have valid identification.
14. The contractor is solely responsible for any accident, pollution, etc. taking place either at NFC while lifting the materials or during transportation or while storing / processing / disposing at their premises.
15. NFC reserves the right to terminate the contract in the interest of the Government at any time during the existence of the contract without assigning any reason.
16. During the existence of the contract, if the contractor is adjudged bankrupt or if they made a general assignment for the benefit of his creditors or if a receiver should be appointed for any reason or the contractor winds up his establishment or goes into

liquidation on account of insolvency, or if they refuse to comply with any of the conditions either in part or in full, NFC shall forfeit the performance guarantee and security deposit. This clause does not curtail any of the rights or remedies NFC may deem if fit to take against the contractor.

17. Earnest Money Deposit at the rate of 2% of estimated cost put to tender shall be submitted along with tender in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt / Crossed Demand Draft drawn in favour of "Pay and Accounts Officer, NFC" payable at Hyderabad. Offers without EMD will be summarily rejected.
18. Certificate from Officer-in-charge at NFC regarding payment of minimum wages to the contract labour is to be enclosed along with the claim.
19. Valid medical fitness certificate from at least an MBBS doctor for the workers/drivers engaged for collection of material shall be submitted. The contractor shall ensure that they are covered under ESI and EPF. Proof of the same shall be produced before start of work.
20. The quoted value shall be inclusive of GST, transportation charges and any other mandatory duties and levies of the Government and exclusive of ESI / EPF. The payment towards ESI, EPF will be released against submission of documentary evidence towards payment of ESI, EPF to the concerned authorities.
21. The contractor shall provide the registration details of Income Tax, GST, ESI, EPF etc. while collecting tender document and copies of the same shall be submitted along with tender document.
22. Performance Guarantee @ 5% of Work Order value shall be submitted within 15 days from the date of issue of letter of acceptance in the form Fixed Deposit receipt or Demand Draft or Bank Guarantee. In case a bank guarantee is submitted, it should be valid for a period of 06 (Six) months from the date of issue of work order along with an additional claim period of six (6) months. (Extension of time for submission of Performance guarantee at the request of contractor shall be charged @ 0.1% per day of performance guarantee amount) to a maximum of 15 days.
23. In case of non-submission of Performance Guarantee within prescribed/extended time, the Earnest Money Deposit submitted will be forfeited.
24. Security Deposit @ 2.5% of the Work Order Value shall be recovered from Running Account bills. The Security Deposit amount recovered shall be released after Three (3) months from the date of completion of entire work, or after payment of final bill, whichever is later.
25. Bills in duplicate submitted for payment shall be GST compliant. Contractor shall furnish his PAN No. and bank details along with a xerox copy of the same duly countersigned by him.
26. Payment for the work done by the contractor shall be made based on the work done by contractor which was accepted and measured by the Officer in charge, duly approved by the Competent authority.
27. Offers received will be evaluated based on the total cost quoted inclusive of GST and exclusive of ESI, EPF.
28. Income tax and GST as applicable at source shall be deducted from the payments made. Non submission of PAN or incorrect PAN no. attracts income tax @ 20 % on the gross bill. Contractor must furnish their PAN no. and bank details along with a photocopy of the same duly attested by him.
29. The offer should be kept valid for a period of three months from the date of opening of tender.
30. Incomplete and conditional tenders shall be rejected. However unconditional rebates are acceptable.
31. Contractors shall quote the rates both in words and figures.
32. In case there is a variation between the rates in figures and words, the rate which corresponds to amount worked out by the contractor shall be taken as correct.

33. When the amount of an item is not worked out by the contractor, or if it does not correspond with the rates written either in figures or in words, then the rate quoted by the contractor in words shall be taken as correct.
34. When the rate quoted by the contractor, in figures and in words tallies, but the amount is not worked out correctly, the rate quoted by the contractor shall be taken as correct and not the amount.
35. Contractor shall sign each page of the tender document along with the schedule of quantities & rates.
36. In case the contractor fails to commence the work specified in the tender document within the prescribed time schedule, then the Government shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy be at liberty to forfeit whole EMD absolutely.
37. The contractor shall ensure that labour deployed for the contract would confine themselves to their respective places of work and not indulge in activities that would be harmful to NFC.
38. The contractor shall ensure that labour deployed for the contract would confine themselves to their respective places of work and not involve in activities that would be harmful to NFC. The contract labour shall be / below 60 years for skilled, shall be / below 50 years for unskilled, shall be / below 65 years for highly skilled categories.
39. If on acceptance of the tender, owing to the circumstances if the scope of the work remains altered, reduced or abandoned for any reason NFC shall give a notice in writing to that effect to the contractor who shall act accordingly. Also, if the workmanship is not satisfactory, the contract shall be cancelled.
40. Before quoting, the contractor may visit NFC for assessment of work with prior permission of Manager, EM section. He may contact at 040-27183268/040-27184206.
41. If the contractor fails to execute the work completely, then the Government shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy be at liberty to forfeit whole Security Deposit and Performance Bank Guarantee absolutely.
42. The quoted rates shall not be less than the minimum wage fixed / notified by the state government - where the service is performed and shall include all statutory obligations. However bids without any element of cost over and above such minimum wage (or below it) shall be treated as "Nil" price quotation and would be rejected. The contractor shall be liable for all kinds of dues payable in respect of all personnel provided under the contract and NFC shall not be liable for availing the services of the personnel. The contractor should ensure that persons to be deployed are not alcoholic, drug addict and not indulge in any activity prejudicial to NFC. The contractor shall ensure to get Police Verification for all the manpower deployed by them and the contractor shall ensure that the manpower deputed should bear good moral character.
