TERMS & CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT

1.0 GENERAL INFORMATION:

The site at Pazhayakayal is located on the Gulf of Mannar coast in Srivaikundam Taluk, Tuticorin Dist, Tamilnadu, which is at a distance of about 577 kms by road from Chennai. The nearest town Tuticorin is located at a distance of about 17 kms North of the site. The nearest Railway station Tuticorin (BG) of Southern Railways is at 18 kms from the site. The site is approachable through the National highway between Tuticorin and Thiruchendur.

2.0 SCOPE OF WORK:

- 2.1 The Security Agency shall provide one (01) Security Supervisor and Twenty one (21) Security Guards (07 Security Guards in 03 Shifts) to be deployed in round-the-clock shifts on 24x7 basis all the 07 days of the week at Zirconium Complex Township and approach road to plant site, Zirconium Complex. Zirconium Complex reserves the right to increase/decrease the number of security personnel to be deployed by the Security Agency at any time by giving advance notice of 30 days to the Security Agency.
- 2.2 The Security Agency shall also ensure that they are deploying preferably Ex-Servicemen who are physically & mentally fit with clear record below 45 years of age. In case ZC (P) found any of the security personnel deployed by the Security Agency is not physically and mentally fit, the Security Agency is liable to replace him immediately.
- 2.3 The Security agency shall deploy only those security personnel whose antecedents have been verified by the concerned Police Authorities. Police Verification Certificates (PVCs) issued by concerned Superintendent of Police may be submitted to ZC (P) authorities prior to their deployment.
- 2.4 The security personnel (Ex-servicemen) so made available by the Security Agency for rendering security services at ZC Township and approach road to plant site shall be deployed as decided by the ZC(P) and in that connection the Security Agency has to co-ordinate with the Administrative Officer-III / Estate Officer of the ZC(P) or with any other officer authorized by him.
- 2.5 The ZC(P) will identify the place of deployment of Security Guards/Supervisors and accordingly the Security Agency will arrange to deploy them. The Security Agency shall ensure that the security personnel employed by them are functioning in a smooth manner in close liaison with various authorities of the ZC(P).
- 2.6 The Security Agency should ensure that the security personnel deployed by them have thorough knowledge of security procedures and operating Fire Fighting Equipments installed in the ZC Township area and ensure that they follow the safety codes.

- 2.7 The ZC(P) shall give necessary direction to the Duty Supervisor in case of necessity for mobilizing the force/extra force and the same is binding on the Duty Supervisor employed by the Security Agency. The Supervisor is liable to be present as and when called for by the Administrative Officer-III / Estate Officer of ZC (P) or his authorized representatives.
- 2.8 The Security Agency shall ensure that all the employees deployed by them wear proper uniform with ID Cards duly displayed during duty hours and that they are courteous, polite and prompt while performing duties in their respective area and shall not leave the duty post unless and until they are properly relieved by the relievers.
- 2.9 The ZC(P) reserves the right to replace the Security Guards / Supervisors without assigning any reasons thereof and the Security Agency shall at all times comply with such request of ZC(P).
- 2.10 Deployment of any fresh security personnel by the Security Agency in replacement shall be made only with prior permission of ZC (P).
- 2.11 The security personnel shall be adequately briefed/trained about their duties prior to deployment.
- 2.12 The Security Agency shall always ensure the availability of the security personnel as per the requirement of the ZC(P) at its disposal. In the event of any security personnel being on leave/absent, the agency shall ensure alternative arrangement to make up for such absence. To meet such eventualities, the agency shall make provision for leave reserves.
- 2.13 The performance of the security agency personnel will be supervised by the supervisor from the security agency as well as Administrative Officer, ZC(P) or his representatives.
- 2.14 The overall control and supervision of Private Security Agency personnel shall be under Administrative Officer, ZC(P) or his representatives.
- 2.15 The Security Agency shall observe all the Labour Laws and such other statutory rules as applicable to the employees engaged by them. In case of any violation, the Security Agency is liable for action enforced under any Law. In the event of any liability incurred towards the same by ZC(P) in the capacity as Principal Employers, the same shall be recovered from the Security Agency.
- 2.16 Records, registers like Muster, Payment of Wages Register, Over Time Register (if any), Leave Register and any other registers/records required to be maintained under various statute or maintainable under the agreement are to be maintained by the Security Agency.
- 2.17 The Security Agency shall provide all material(s)/equipment(s) required for day to day security requirement like Torches, Whistles, Batons, Two sets of summer uniform(sky blue shirt and navy blue trouser), one jersey(navy blue)/overcoat, one pair of black leather shoe, cap beret, lanyard per-annum, and protective material like raincoats etc. However ZC(P) shall make available necessary registers to the Security Agency for recording entries of visitors/vehicles and material movement etc. In case any complaint

is received from Security Personnel regarding non receipt of proper uniform and also timely issue of uniform, ZC(P) has the right to initiate suitable action as deemed fit.

- 2.18 The Security Agency is responsible for submission of periodical return or any other return to the concerned authorities and also to ZC(P) as and when directed.
- 2.19 The Administrative Officer-III / Estate Officer or his representative shall be the Officer-in-Charge of the work relating to the agreement.
- 2.20 All liabilities arising out of an accident or death of security personnel deployed by security agency while on duty shall be borne by Security Agency.
- 2.21 Any liability arising out of any litigation (including) those in consumer courts due to any act or omission by security personnel shall be directly borne by security agency including all expenses/fines. Security personnel shall attend the Court as and when required.

3.0 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- 3.1 The security agencies shall have valid license of registration under Private Security Agency (Regulation) Act 2005 or equivalent act in the state.
- 3.2 The agency shall Empanelled with Directorate General of Resettlement (DGR), New Delhi.
- 3.3 The agency shall have minimum 5 years of experience of security services and have a live registration continuously for last five years.
- 3.4 The agency shall have strength of 5 times the required number of manpower so as to ensure continuous supply of requisite number of Security Personnel in case of absenteeism, leave etc.
- 3.5 Preference will be given to Agencies set up by and comprising of Ex-Servicemen.
- 3.6 Each Security personnel deployed by the agency shall possess valid Police Verification Certificate (PVC) issued by the concerned State Police Authorities.
- 3.7 There should be no criminal case pending with the police against the Proprietor/ Partner/ Security Agency.
- 3.8 Security Guards shall be mentally and physically sound and shall be below age of 45 years.

4.0 DUTIES TO BE PERFORMED:

Security personnel provided by Security Agency shall perform the following security duties in ZC Township and approach road to plant site, Zirconium Complex, Pazhayakayal.

- 4.1 Guarding the important places/installations such as Telephone Exchange, Boundary Walls of the ZC Township, Colony Health Centre, Guest House, Civil/Electrical Colony Offices, Shopping Complex, AECS School, Sewage Treatment Plant area, Thamirabharani Guest House, Pump House, approach road to plant site and the vacant quarters in the ZC Township and other places inside the Township or approach road to plant site as per the requirement.
- 4.2 Maintaining visitors/vehicles movement records at gates as required by ZC(P).
- 4.3 Checking the identity of outsiders/visitors entering the colony so as to ensure that no unauthorized persons/anti social elements are entering the ZC Township.
- 4.4 Checking and keeping the record of outgoing material through valid gate passes.
- 4.5 Checking/watching the movement of employees/labourers engaged by various contractors in ZC Township and approach road.
- 4.6 Reporting of any untoward incident in ZC Township and approach road to plant site area, if any.
- 4.7 Ensuring that no cattle/stray animals are entering in the residential colony /approach road and in case of their entry from any part of ZC Township they should be driven out of township/approach road.
- 4.8 Assistance to ZC(P) authorities in checking the sub-letting of government accommodations/shops and also helping ZC(P) authorities in evicting the unauthorized occupants from the Government Quarters/Shops.
- 4.9 Checking of any pilferage in electricity or water and giving assistance to the ZC(P) authorities in implementing anti-sabotage/theft measures
- 4.10 Compliance of instructions/orders in the matter of security issued by ZC(P) authorities or any other agency through ZC(P).

5.0 PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE:

Performance Guarantee @ 10% of one months wage bill shall be deposited in the form of FDR/DD/BG within 15 days from the date of issue of the Letter of Acceptance. In case a Bank Guarantee is furnished, it shall be valid upto stipulated period of contract along with an additional claim period of six months. Extension of time for submission of Performance Guarantee at the request of contractor shall be charged @ 0.1% per day of Performance Guarantee amount.

The amount of Performance Guarantee will be refunded after 3 months from the date of issue of completion certificate or after settlement of final bill whichever is later.

6.0 PAYMENT TERMS:

- 6.1 The contractor shall submit the monthly running bill in triplicate in the form required by the Officer-In-Charge along with attendance register duly completed in respect of claims relating to the preceding month and the bill should be accompanied with pre-receipt affixing revenue stamp. The RA bill or final bill will be accepted only after submission of the Labour Payment Certificate from LCWO, ZC(P).
- 6.2 Paying Authority for this work is PAO, NFC, Hyderabad.
- 6.3 The Security Agency is liable to comply with the provisions of payment of Wages Act, 1970 and Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Rules, 1971 (all as amended from time to time).
- 6.4 The contractor shall comply with the provisions of the Minimum Wages Act 1948, Payment of Wages Act, Contract Labour (Regulation and abolition) Act 1970 and rules framed there under and other Labour Laws that may be brought into force from time to time. Employer's contribution towards EPF and ESI shall be borne by the Contractor.
- 6.5 The Income Tax and GST as applicable shall be deducted from the bills.
- 6.6 GST shall be reimbursable in the subsequent month on production of documentary evidence towards remittance of the same with concerned authorities.
- 6.7 Any complaint from any employee deployed by the Security Agency to the Government pertaining to non-payment of wages etc. shall be dealt with as per the rules in vogue and payment made for the purpose shall be recovered from the Security Agency.
- 6.8 **There will be no escalation in the rates during the currency of the contract.**

7.0 PENALTY:

- 7.1 The Security Agency shall ensure that all the employees deployed by them wear proper uniform with ID Cards duly displayed during duty hours and that they are courteous, polite and prompt while performing duties in their respective area. If any security personnel found performing duty without proper uniform, a penalty of Rs 500/- for each such occasion shall be levied.
- 7.2 If any of the security personnel is found negligent/sleeping/drunk while on duty during surprise check by any authorized officer of ZC(P), a penalty of Rs 500/- for each such incident shall be levied and same will be deducted from the security agency's bill and the security agency has to withdraw that person immediately.

- 7.3 If any complaint is received attributable to misconduct/misbehavior on the part of Security Guards/Supervisors/deployed by the Security Agency and is assessed as true by ZC(P) authorities, a penalty of Rs 500/- for each such incident shall be levied and same will be deducted from the security agency's bill. Besides the security personnel found involved in the incident shall be removed from ZC Township under intimation to the Security Agency.
- 7.4 Any damage or loss caused to ZC Township/ZC(P) in any form due to negligence of security personnel deployed by the Security Agency during the course of its tenure, the same shall be made good by the Security Agency.
- 7.5 If any duty post remains vacant and the Security Agency fails to provide/deploy the manpower on any day / shift, a penalty equal to double the wages for number of Guards/Supervisors remained absent on that particular day / shift shall be levied by ZC(P) and same shall be deducted from the monthly bills.
- 7.6 In case the security agency fails to commence/execute the work as stipulated in the agreement or gives unsatisfactory performance or does not meet the statutory requirements of the contract, ZC(P) reserves the right to impose the penalty of 1% of annual cost of work order per week up to four weeks delay and after four weeks delay.
- 7.7 ZC(P) reserves the right to cancel the contract and withhold the agreement and get this work done from other security agency in open market. The difference, if any, will be recovered from the defaulter security agency.

8.0 VALIDITY OF OFFER:

- 8.1 The offer shall be valid for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of Financial Bid and no request for any variation in quoted rates/withdrawal of tender on any ground by successful bidder shall be entertained.

9.0 DURATION OF CONTRACT:

The duration of contract will be initially for a period of 02 (two) years from the date of its commencement and can be extended for a further period of 01 (one) year, by mutual consent, on the same terms and conditions of the contract and at the same rates. The rates quoted by the bidder shall remain unchanged during the period of contract.

10.0 TERMINATION OF CONTRACT:

- 10.1 If the contractor breaches the contract during the course of contract performance guarantee shall be forfeited in addition to other legal remedies available under the contract act.
- 10.2 ZC (P) reserves the right to terminate the agreement at any point of time without assigning any reasons thereof by giving 30 days advance notice to the Security Agency and in that event the Security Agency shall not be entitled for any compensation

10.3 Dy. General Manager, ZC(P) reserves the right of deciding any matter arising during the tenure of the contract, but not covered specifically by the conditions mentioned in the tender and that decision of ZC(P) in this regard shall be final and binding on the contractor.

11.0 FORCE MAJEURE:

If at any time during the currency of contract, either party is subject to force majeure, which can be termed as civil disturbance, riots, strikes, natural calamities etc. which may prevent either party to discharge his obligation. The affected party shall promptly notify the other party about happening of such event. Neither party shall by reason of such event be entitled to terminate the contract in respect of such performance of their obligations. The obligations under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after the event has come to an end or ceased to exist.

12.0 SUB CONTRACTS

The Security Agency shall not engage any sub contractor or transfer the contract to any other person in any manner.

13.0 SECRECY:

With a view to safe guard the secrets and confidential information relating to the Zirconium Complex, Pazhayakayal, the bidder binds himself, his successors and assigns, to secrecy and contracts to bind to secrecy his officials, managers, senior staff and all other staff directly or indirectly concerned in or who may have acquired information relating to the Zirconium Complex and the bidder shall ensure (so far as lies his power) that no third party has access to any such information.

14.0 CONFIDENTIALITY:

Security Agency should not disclose any thing to any third party. In particular, information identified as Proprietary in nature by the disclosing party, shall be kept strictly confidential by the receiving party and shall not be disclosed to any third party without prior written consent of the original disclosing party. This clause shall apply to the Security Agency or the employees engaged by the Security Agency with equal force.

15.0 RESTRICTED INFORMATION:

Categories under Section 18 of the Atomic Energy Act 1962 and OFFICIAL SECRETS under Section 5 of the Official Secrets Act 1923:

Any contravention of above-mentioned provisions by the Security Agency or the employees engaged by the Security Agency will invite penal consequences under the aforesaid legislation.

16.0 ARBITRATION (CLAUSE 59 OF G.C.C.):

The Sub Section V “Arbitration and laws etc.” of the General Conditions of the contract for works as stated below shall be applicable to this contract/agreement also:

- 16.1 Except where otherwise provided for in the contract, all questions and disputes relating to the meaning of the specifications, designs, drawing and instructions herein before contained in this contract or as to the quality of the workmanship or materials used on the work or arising out of the terms & conditions of the contract whether during the progress of the work or after the completion or abandonment thereof, at the sole arbitration of the person nominated and appointed by Dy. General Manager, ZC(P) in respect of the contracts entered for and on behalf of the President of India, by any officer/authority of the ZC(P).
- 16.2 The parties of the contract agree there it will be no objection to any such appointment that the sole arbitrator so appointed is originally referred being transferred or having vacated his office or being unable to act for any reason whatsoever, the Dy. General Manager, Zirconium Complex, as aforesaid at the time of such transfer, vacation of office or inability to act, shall appoint another person to act as arbitrator in accordance with the terms of the contract. Such person as and when appointed shall proceed with the reference from the stage at which it was left by his predecessor in accordance with the rules, regulation and the law of the land, it is also a term of this contract that no person other than a person appointed by the Dy. General Manager, ZC(P), as aforesaid should act as arbitrator and if any that is not possible, the matter is not to be referred to arbitration at all.
- 16.3 It is also the terms of the contract that the party invoking the arbitration clause shall specify the dispute(s) to be referred of the arbitration under this contract together with amount(s) claimed in respect of each such dispute(s) or difference(s). In an arbitration invoked at the instance of either party to the contract, the Arbitrator would be free to consider the counterclaims of the other party or even though they are not mentioned in the reference to arbitration.
- 16.4 Subject as aforesaid, the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 (No 20 of 1996) or any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof and rules made there-under and for the time being in force shall apply to the arbitration proceeding under this clause.

17.0 JURISDICTION:

The Court situated in Tuticorin District, Tamilnadu alone will have jurisdiction to adjudicate in the matters arising out of this contract.

18.0 Prohibition against use of ZC(P)’s name without permission for publicity purpose:

The Contractor, Sub-Contractor, Advisor, Consultant or the Employees engaged by the Contractor shall not use Zirconium Complex’s name for any publicity purpose through any public media like Press, Radio, T.V or Internet without prior written approval of ZC (P).
