## **ZIRCONIUM COMPLEX INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERERS**

The Tenderers are required to submit their offer in a sealed cover superscribing thereon "Tender for hiring of Two (02) Nos. Ambulances in round-the-clock shifts (24 x 7) at Zirconium Complex, Pazhayakayal" with tender number and due date. EMD amounting to **Rs.63,200/- (Rupees Sixty Three Thousand Two Hundred Only)** in the form of Demand Draft / FDR should be enclosed with the Quotation. Sealed cover shall be dropped in the tender box kept for the purpose at Veda Prastha Building, Zirconium Complex, Pazhayakayal, Srivaikundam Taluk, Tuticorin District, Tamil Nadu - 628 152. Tender received after the specified date and time will not be considered.

1. Documents to be submitted for obtaining tender form:
  - a. Permanent Account Number alongwith IT returns for the last 3 years.
  - b. List of Parties to whom similar services have been provided by the tenderer, with testimonials and certificates from the clients.
  - c. Solvency Certificate from Bankers or equivalent in support of financial standing.
  - d. 15 digit service tax code number
2. Taxes where legally leviable and included in the rate quoted may be distinctly indicated.
- 3.1 The tender shall be kept valid for a period of 120 days from the date of opening.
- 3.2 Rates are required to be quoted separately as follows:
  - a. Hire charges per month for a minimum of 800 Kilometers run per month for Two (02) Nos. ambulances.
  - b. Hire charges for Extra kilometer run beyond 2000 KMs (i.e. per km).
  - c. Rates should be indicated both in words and figures. In case of any discrepancy between two rates, rate in words will prevail.
- 4.1 The hire charges for one month and for running 800 Kms should be inclusive of all expenses for the operation of vehicles and no claim for other expenses whatsoever is admissible. This includes statutory levies and taxes also and service tax as applicable.
- 4.2 For the purpose of computing the total KMs, run per day, the distance to and from site will be reckoned. In case, the vehicle is run from site to contractor's garage / office for any purpose, the distance run will not be considered for payment.
5. Deputy General Manager, Zirconium Complex, Pazhayakayal shall be under no obligation to accept the lowest or any other tender and shall be entitled to accept or reject any tender in part or full without assigning any reason whatsoever.

6. Entries with corrections, erasers or alterations shall be authenticated by affixing signature of the tenderer.
7. The tenderer should submit alongwith the tender the Registration number of the vehicle proposed to be operated together with the details of year of manufacture, maker's name, seating capacity, ownership, validity of the permit, Insurance, Fitness Certificate and the details of taxes paid etc.
8. The vehicle proposed to be operated under this contract should be preferably brand new vehicle OR Model after **January 2016**. They should be produced for inspection to Zirconium Complex authorities for consideration of the tender. Operation or subsequent change of vehicles, other than those produced during evaluation of the tenders and approved by Zirconium Complex authorities will be subject to prior permission/ inspection by Zirconium Complex.
9. The tenderer shall submit alongwith the tender, the name of his banker as well as the Permanent Account Number issued by the Income Tax Officer of the circle concerned under the seal of his office and IT returns for last 3 years.
10. In case the tenderer is a partnership firm or a Joint Hindu Family concern, the tenderer shall, in a separate sheet, to be annexed to the tender, furnish the names and full particulars of the partners or the member of the Joint Hindu Family owning the concern.
11. The tender must be signed -
  - i) In the event of the tenderer being a Sole Proprietary concern, by the Sole Proprietor or by an Attorney duly authorized to enter into and sign agreements to refer disputes arising under or relating to such agreements to arbitration, by a power of attorney signed by the proprietor and authenticated by a Notary Public or Magistrate.
  - ii) In the event of the tenderer being a partnership Firm, by the Managing Partner/ duly authorized person or by an Attorney duly authorized to enter into and sign agreements on behalf of the partnership firm including agreements to refer disputes arising under or relating to such agreements to arbitration by a power of attorney duly executed by the partners and authenticated by a Notary Public or a Magistrate.
  - iii) In the event of the tenderer being a Limited Company, under the common seal of the Company, or by an attorney duly authorized to enter into and sign agreements to refer disputes arising under or relating to such agreements, to arbitration by power of attorney executed under his common seal and authenticated by a Notary Public or a Magistrate.
  - iv) In the event of the tenderer being a Hindu Joint Family concern, by the Karta of the Joint Family.

When the tender is signed by a attorney of the Sole Proprietor of a concern or when the tender is signed on behalf of the firm by an attorney of its partners as provided in sub- clause (i) & (ii), the original power of attorney, appointing him as such an attorney shall be supplied with the tender or if the tender is executed on behalf of a limited company by its attorney as provided in sub-clause (c) above; the original power of attorney alongwith a resolution (if it is so required under its Articles of Association) authorizing the affixation of its common seal on the power of attorney and a copy of its Articles

of Association shall be appended with the tender.

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. The Ambulances should be equipped with:
  - a) First-aid box with necessary medicines
  - b) Portable oxygen cylinder with flow valve with stand
  - c) Rod-cum-hook to hang saline bottles etc.
  - d) Stretcher (Foldable)
  - e) Ambulance Siren and Pilot lamp at top
2. The Ambulances should be maneuverable at Plant Site/Township.
3. The Ambulances should be available at OHC / CHC on round-the-clock shifts (24x7). The driver must hold valid driving licence and should have undergone training in first-aid. He should assist Zirconium Complex staff in shifting/transporting the patients to the hospitals (to and fro). Drivers should compulsorily wear uniform viz. White shirt and white pant on duty.
4. The successful tenderer (s) shall enter into an agreement with Zirconium Complex

#### 5. Period of Contract

The contract shall commence from the date of entering into agreement to provide Ambulances on hire and shall remain "in force (unless terminated earlier as provided hereinafter) for a period of two years and the contract may be extended for a further period up to **Two (02) years**, at the discretion of Deputy General Manager, Zirconium Complex, Pazhayakayal.

Deputy General Manager, Zirconium Complex, Pazhayakayal reserves the right to terminate the contract at anytime without assigning any reasons therefor by giving 30 days notice of his intention to do so in writing to the contractor and the contractor shall not be entitled to any compensation by reason of such termination.

#### 6. Right to enter into parallel contracts

- 6.1 Deputy General Manager, Zirconium Complex, Pazhayakayal, reserves the right to enter into parallel contracts with any other party as and when considered desirable and necessary during the currency of the contract.
- 6.2 If the contractor fails at any time to render the services under this contract to the satisfaction of the Deputy General Manager, Zirconium Complex, Pazhayakayal whose decision in this regard shall be final and binding on the Contractor, he may at his option get the work done by other parties. In such a case, the contractor is liable to reimburse the loss / extra expenditure incurred by Zirconium Complex, Pazhayakayal in this regard.
- 6.3 If the vehicle is found unsatisfactory in respect of its road worthiness, performance, seats, body (doors, windows etc.) or any of the equipment mentioned in point (1) above, and general condition during the tenure of this contract, Deputy General Manager, Zirconium Complex, Pazhayakayal reserves the right to ask the contractor to repair or replace the vehicle. If the contractor does not maintain or repair the vehicle to the satisfaction, Deputy General Manager, Zirconium Complex, Pazhayakayal can engage the required vehicle through any other agency and the contractor shall reimburse to Zirconium Complex, Pazhayakayal

on this account.

## 7. Performance Guarantee & Security Deposit :

- 7.1 The Contractor shall furnish an irrecoverable "Performance Guarantee" for an amount equivalent to 5% of the contract value within 15 days of issue of letter of award for proper performance of contract. This guarantee shall be in the form of Demand Draft or Fixed Deposit Receipts or Guarantee Bonds of any Scheduled Bank or State Bank of India. This performance guarantee bond shall be valid up to the stipulated contract period plus 60 days beyond that alongwith an additional claim period of six months.
- 7.2 The total security deposit for the contract is 2.5% of the contract value, which is recoverable @ 2.5% of gross running bills till the total SD amount is made up.
- 7.3 All compensation or other sums of money payable by the contractor under the terms and conditions of the contract may be deducted from the Security Deposit or from any sums which may be due or may become due to the contractor from Zirconium Complex, Pazhayakayal on any account whatsoever.
- 7.4 Without prejudice to any rights or remedies under any of the provisions of the contract, Deputy General Manager, Zirconium Complex, Pazhayakayal has absolute right to forfeit the Performance Guarantee and Security Deposit recovered till date for breach of any of the terms and conditions of the contract by the contractor.
- 7.5 The Security deposit shall bear no interest. The Security Deposit will be returned after three months after the expiry of then contract period including extensions, if any, subject to the satisfactory performance of the Contractor. In case the tenderer fails to furnish Performance Guarantee within the stipulated period, and or fails to commence work awarded to him immediately, the **Earnest Money Deposit of Rs.63,200/-** furnished by him shall be forfeited to the President of India. Similarly, the Performance Guarantee and Security Deposit shall be forfeited or appropriated towards any loss sustained by Zirconium Complex, Pazhayakayal as a result of any breach of the terms and conditions by the contractor. The Performance Guarantee, shall, however, be returned to the contractor on due and satisfactory performance of the contract and on completion of all obligations by the contractor under the terms of the contract and his submitting a "**No Demand Certificate**" from the Deputy General Manager, Zirconium Complex, Pazhayakayal.
- 7.6 IT deduction at source at the prevailing rate will be deducted from the gross payment date. Your PAN may be indicated with the offer.

## 8. Operation and maintenance of vehicles

- 8.1 The contractor shall ensure that vehicle is run in accordance with the prevailing traffic regulations, prescribed speed limits and as per the Motor Vehicles Act/Rules.
- 8.2 Proper maintenance of the vehicle and keeping roadworthy shall be the responsibility of the contractor. The remuneration etc. of drivers or any other personnel will have to be borne by the contractor including all statutory levies.

Hours of work, wages etc. of the drivers or any other personnel shall be in accordance with the prevailing laws from time to time.



- 8.3 All the formalities, Rules and Regulations imposed by the State or Local Authority connected with the plying of vehicle should be adhered to. The Contractor shall abide by Municipal Bye-laws, Rules and Regulations and also by the laws of the State and Central Government in force from time to time pertaining to the contractor's establishment including those employed by him directly or through a sub-contractor. Any penalty or fine levied on account of negligence and breach of any Laws/Rules/Regulations in force shall be borne solely by the Contractor.
- 8.4 In case of emergency situation like labour unrest etc at Zirconium Complex, Pazhayakayal the contractor shall make all efforts to run his vehicle normally.
- 8.5 The vehicle should be preferably a brand new vehicle OR model after January 2016 and should be in good running condition, roadworthy, and comfortable to the commuters such as having window panes, cushion seats, leak proof during monsoon/winter period.
- 8.6 In case of breakdown of the vehicle enroute, a relief vehicle should be provided by the contractor immediately, so that there is no dislocation in the service or inconvenience to the patients. In case this relief vehicle does not take over the service from the break down vehicle and reach destination within one hour, it would amount to non-operation and a penalty of Rs.500/- per trip (One way) will be levied in addition to non-payment of hire charges for that trip on pro-rata basis.
- 8.7 In case the vehicle is not operated on any particular day, a penalty of Rs.500/- plus an amount on pro-rata basis will be deducted from the bills.
9. The contractor should make his own arrangements at his own expenses for filling fuel, lubricants etc. and check the condition of the vehicle for ensuring road worthiness and good running condition before each trip. The contractor shall ensure availability of the fuel and lubricants in the vehicle run by him well in advance and should not take the vehicles for filling diesel/lubricants while commuting the patients.
10. The driver of the vehicle should wear uniform and possess mobile phone to know the movement of the vehicle from time to time. The Contractor should provide uniforms and mobile phones to the drivers of the vehicle.

11. **Subletting of the contract**

The contractor shall not sublet, transfer or assign the whole or any part of the contract.

12. **Revision of rates**

No request for revision of the rates will be entertained during the period of contract. However, if the price of fuel increases, the contractor shall be compensated for such increase as per details given below and the amount of the contract shall accordingly be varied, such compensation in the prices of fuel shall be worked out based on the following provisions.

- a) The base rate for working out such escalation shall be last date on which tenders were stipulated to be received.
- b) The compensation for such increase for fuel shall be worked out for the month as per the formula given below based on the price as on 1<sup>st</sup> day

of the month.

$$\frac{\text{Present Fuel Rate - (Subtract) Base Rate (Increase / Decrease) respective}}{\text{(Divided by) Fuel efficiency of the vehicle per litre}} \times \text{Actual Kilometer run in period by vehicle}$$

- c) The base price for fuel shall be the one relating to the month in which the tender was stipulated to be received.
- d) Fuel efficiency of the vehicle per litre should be furnished in the quotation by the tenderer.
- e) In the event the prices of fuel decreases, there shall be downward adjustment and amount will be recovered from the contractor. In this regard, the formula stated hereinbefore under Para (b) shall mutatis mutandis apply.
- f) Contractor shall produce the documentary proof to claim compensation for increase in payment of fuel from the recognized Association / Petroleum Company.

13. **Insurance**

It is the responsibility of the contractor to insure the Ambulances and pay all expenses like premium, vehicle taxes/other taxes, any fees etc. The risk of the passengers traveling in the vehicle, as also third party risk, should be covered by the contractor to the extent of the liability specified in the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 as amended from time to time.

- 14. The documents pertaining to Registration of vehicles, licence of drivers, payment of taxes, insurance permits etc., should be produced on demand to Zirconium Complex, Pazhayakayal for verification.
- 15. For services rendered under this contract, the contractor will submit his bill in triplicate to Zirconium Complex, Pazhayakayal for services rendered during the preceding month by 3<sup>rd</sup> of succeeding month.

16. **Settlement of dispute / difference by Arbitration:**

- a. Except where otherwise provided in the contract, all disputes and differences concerning this contract or arising out of the terms and conditions of this contract whether during or after the expiry of the validity of the contract shall be referred to the sole arbitration of the Chief Executive, Nuclear Fuel Complex, Hyderabad or to the person appointed by him.
- b. It will be no objection, that the Arbitrator so appointed is a government servant, that he had to deal with matters to which the contract relates to or that in the course of his duties as a Government servant he had expressed views on all or any of the matters in dispute or difference. The Arbitrator, to whom the matter is originally referred, being transferred or vacating his office or being unable to act for any reason, the Authority as aforesaid shall appoint another person to act as an Arbitrator in accordance with the terms

of the contract. Such person shall be entitled to proceed with the reference from the stage at which his predecessor left it.

c. Subject to the conditions aforesaid, the provisions of the Arbitration Act or any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof and the rules made thereunder and for the time being in force shall apply to arbitration proceedings under this clause.

d. It is also a term of the contract that the party invoking the arbitration shall specify dispute or disputes to be referred to arbitration under this clause together with the amount claimed in respect of each such dispute.

17. The Courts situated in Tuticorin or the Honorable High Court of Tamil Nadu will have jurisdiction to adjudicate the matters arising out of this contract.

18. The contractor has to comply with the provision of Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970 and rules and orders issued thereunder from time to time. It is obligatory on the part of the contractor that workers employed by him are paid under the Minimum Wages Act. The contractor shall also obtain licence for deploying manpower as prescribed under Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970.
